Reply :- Your queries: 1. Is the vaccine voluntary?

2. If a person does not take the vaccine, can the government and any private company stop the salary and facilities of that person? while bypassing the universal human rights found in article 21.

3. If the person has side effects and death after taking the vaccine, will the vaccine company and the government be responsible for it? Is there any compensation provision on such incident?

4. Can the vaccinated people still spread corona virus? Has any research been done on transmission and self-spreading of covid vaccine?

5. The vaccine is currently on clinical trial phase 3 and is being given to the emergency use authorization, has its clinical trial data been given to the public?

Reply: Your RTI application has been forwarded by RTI Cell of this Ministry i.e. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare/Other CPIO(s) to the concerned/other CPIO(s) also. Therefore, as far as this Cell/Office i.e. COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Cell (CVAC)/Undersigned CPIO is concerned, the information/reply in respect of point/query (1,2,3) pertaining to this office is as under:

Vaccination for COVID-19 is voluntary.

However, it is advisable to receive the complete schedule of COVID-19 vaccine for protecting oneself against this disease and also to limit the spread of this disease to the close contacts including family members, friends, relatives and co-workers.

Vaccination for COVID-19 is voluntary, therefore, no one can be deprived of any kind of Government service/facility/schemes due to non taking COVID vaccination.

COVID Vaccines like other drugs are licensed after due deliberations and consideration of safety data by Drug Controller General of India (DCGI). Vaccination for COVID-19 is voluntary. There is no provision of financial assistance/compensation for adverse event following COVID-19 Vaccine, if any. However, severe and serious Adverse Events Following Immunization (AEFI) cases may be reported to and treated at Government Hospital/facilities.
