The National AEFI Committee reported on 31st March, 2021, that there have been 305 cases of serious events requiring hospitalization, 65 cases of serious events which did not require hospitalization and 124 deaths after vaccination. In 124 deaths, 63 deaths have been categorised as being caused due to acute coronary syndrome (a range of conditions associated with sudden, reduced blood flow to the heart) or heart attack. Another 11 deaths (12%) of deaths are due to stroke. 4. Yes, the digital vaccination certificate may be used as a validation proof currently for travel within India to certain states which require a negative RT-PCR report or the final certificate of vaccination which is available for beneficiaries who have been administered 2 doses of the vaccines.</p>
